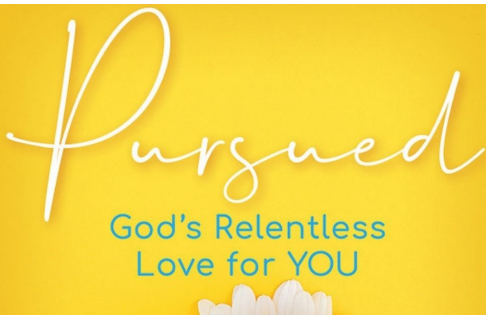

Englewood Community Care Clinic is OPEN!



The mission of the Englewood Community Care Clinic is to provide free medical services to uninsured and working poor in the greater Englewood area. The clinic is located in the Mac Horton West County Annex, 6868 San Casa Drive in Englewood. We serve residents of both Charlotte and Sarasota counties, ages 18-64, who do not have health insurance, Medicaid or Medicare. The clinic is open on Monday and Thursday evenings at 5pm for in-person patient visits. Weekly telehealth visits are also available for patients who prefer to not come to the clinic. Over 50 physicians, nurses and clerical volunteers are involved in serving patients at the clinic (many are EUMC members!). We would appreciate your spreading the word about our work to those in our community who need help. We are anxious to serve!

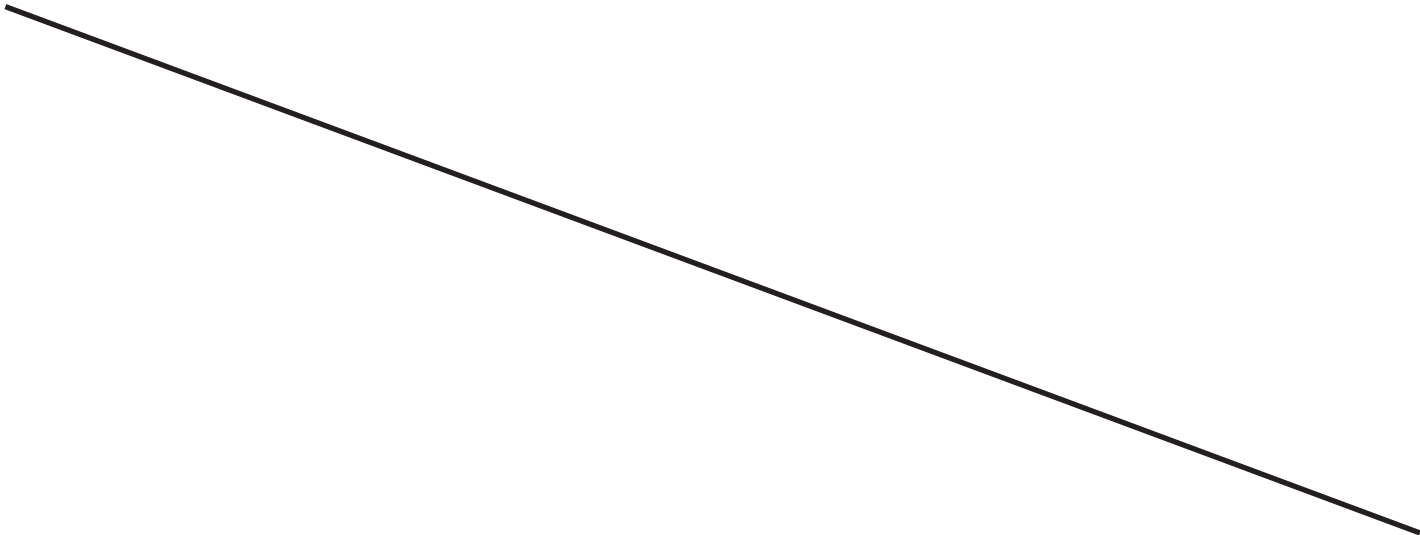

